(a) **Research**

Trinity College has, as part of its strategic plan, committed to a significant investment of money and faculty, in order to position the Theological School as a national leader in theological research. A more stringent set of research metrics has been devised and approved to stimulate research activity; increased funding for conference participation has been allocated; the College has employed a full-time, fully-funded (Level B) postdoctoral fellow; and has funded a 3-year Research Professorship.
