(a) **Research**

St Mark's Review has been a leading journal of Christian thought and opinion since 1955, supporting and promoting Australian theologians and research. It has been a peer reviewed journal since 2014 and is listed on the 2018 ERA list of journals. Since 2018 it has been available on the ATLA Plus database, receiving 5000 plus hits per year internationally. Four themed issues were published in 2019-20:

- Disability, secularisation, Australian religious culture
- Theology and the arts: Australian perspectives
- The God we worship: conversations with Katherine Sonderegger
- Emerging scholars in Australian theology
