The College is looking for a trainer with linguistic qualifications and experience in Bible translation. The College currently offers the 'Certificate II in Indigenous Translating' to grow the skills and knowledge of Indigenous translators in the principles and processes of Bible translation. All students come from remote Northern Territory communities.

The College is seeking an active and enthusiastic Christian trainer to work within an ecumenical environment. Experience in applied linguistics and/or translation fields is highly desirable. Indigenous people are encouraged to apply, but this is not a requirement of the position.

#### **Required Criteria:**

- A committed Christian believer and church member
- Qualifications in Linguistics
- Willingness to work sensitively and effectively within an ecumenical environment that values Indigenous cultures and First Languages

## Desirable Criteria:

- Current Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (or willingness to obtain within 6 months of commencement\*)
- Experience training and/or working with leaders from remote Indigenous communities
- English as an Additional Language/Dialect (EAL/D) teaching experience

\*Nungalinya may cover half the cost of the qualification.

#### Police Check and Ochre Card

All staff at Nungalinya are required to pass a Police Check and obtain an Ochre Card (for working with children). This is at the employee's expense and must be applied for at the time of commencing work.

If you cannot satisfactorily pass the Police Check and Ochre Card, you must discuss this with the College prior to commencing employment.
